

PASSIVE SENTENCES

Vamos a pasar una oración activa a pasiva.

Francisco walks the dog

- Primero, ponemos el objeto directo como sujeto de la pasiva →
The dog
- Después, añadimos el verbo *to be* en el tiempo verbal de la activa. En este caso es *Present Simple* →
The dog is
- Ahora incluimos el verbo principal de la activa en forma de *Past Participle* →
The dog is walked
- Finalmente, añadimos el sujeto de la activa introducido por *by* al final →
The dog is walked by Francisco.
