#### Grammar Box: Comparative and superlative adjectives

We use comparative and superlative adjectives to make comparisons between things.

Comparative adjectives compare one thing with another.

*e.g. Madrid is big.*

*Bangkok is bigger.*

We usually make comparisons with *than*.

*e.g. Bangkok is bigger than Madrid.*

Superlative adjectives compare one thing with several others (more than two).

We use *the* before the superlative adjective.

*e.g. Trento is the smallest city.*
