

♦ **DESCRIPTION** Provincetown is a seaside town 50 miles east of Boston. It has a population of 3,000 and is on the beautiful beaches of Cape Cod.

♦ **PLACES OF INTEREST** The Pilgrim Monument is a museum with a tall tower. It is more than 100 years old and it is open every day. Cape Cod National Seashore is a huge park with beaches, views, and walks.

♦ **TRAVEL** Provincetown is about 2 hours from Boston by car. There are three boats a day from Boston. The boat takes about 45 minutes. Provincetown also has a small airport.

♦ **HOTELS** There are many hotels in Provincetown. Two good hotels are the Brass Key and the Crowne Pointe Inn, both on Bradford Street.

♦ **SHOPPING** There are many art galleries in town. There are also a lot of places for used furniture, clothing, candy, and souvenirs.

♦ **RESTAURANTS AND CAFES** Provincetown is famous for its fish and seafood. There are also Italian, Thai, and Portuguese restaurants. There are coffee shops and ice cream shops near the beach.

♦ **SUPERMARKETS** The town has a big supermarket, Stop & Shop, on Commercial Street. There are a few small supermarkets in town.

♦ **ENTERTAINMENT** There are movies, plays, and concerts at the Art House. The town has an international movie festival in June.
