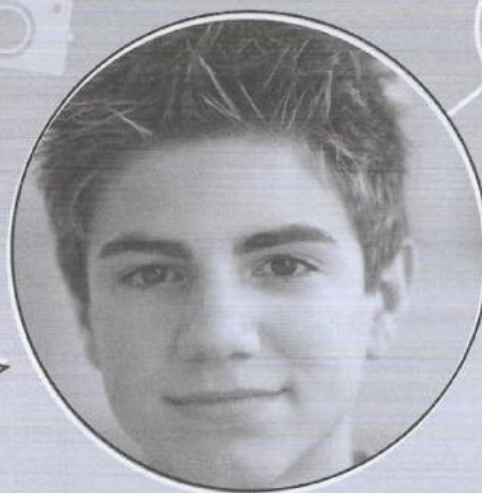


# WORK EXPERIENCE
