

FIRST AND SECOND CONDITIONAL

THEORY: FIRST CONDITIONAL

Expresa planes de futuro, amenazas, advertencias, promesas o se usa para convencer a alguien acerca de algo.

If I try hard, I'll succeed. (*Si me esfuerzo, lo lograré.*)

THEORY: SECOND CONDITIONAL

El second conditional se usa para hablar de situaciones hipotéticas futuras o presentes que es poco probable que se hagan realidad, como esperanzas, sueños y fantasías.

If I had enough money, I'd buy a new house. (*Si tuviera dinero suficiente, me compraría una casa nueva.*)
