Would you like to live in a cave?

Can you imagine living in a cave on the side of a mountain? Well, that is what millions of people in the Shanxi province in northern China have (1) _____ for thousands of years.

They call their caves 'yaodong' and the families who live there usually pass their homes on from parents to children. Some families, like the Guo family, have had the same cave (2) _____ over three hundred years.

Mr and Mrs Guo are farmers. Their farm is small but it is (3) _____ to their 'yaodong', so it is easy for them to walk there. They grow vegetables and they keep some goats and sheep. It's a good life, but it's far away from the city and there are no cinemas or restaurants nearby. The Guos' cave is very comfortable. Many years ago, their relatives carved the cave into the mountainside and made it

their home. Today, they have three rooms next to each other with big windows looking out on to the countryside. Towards the back of the rooms, there are bedrooms. The kitchen, (5) _____ room and living room are in the front so they get more natural light. When it's sunny, the Guos sit outside.

One of the great things about living in a cave is the fact that it's really warm in winter and cool in summer. This is because it is inside the mountain, with only one outside (6) _____. But there isn't any running water or electricity and when the Guos' son finished university, he didn't want to return to the 'yaodong'. He got a job in the city and now he lives there with his family. He has a modern flat, but he still spends his holidays back in the 'yaodong'.
