Two men have been rescued after their light plane crashed in Western Australia's Goldfields. Police say that the plane crashed near Lake Cowan, 120 kilometers east of Kaigoorlie. In addition to the 67-year-old pilot, rescuers also saved the 50-year-old passenger. The rescue was relatively straightforward although the injured pilot and passenger had to wait for the strong winds to dissipate before they could be flown by helicopter for treatment.

The European spacecraft Rosetta has performed a fly-by of a massive asteroid taking images that could one day help Earth defend itself from destruction, the European Space Agency (ESA) said.

Moreover, the aim of the fly-by was to measure the mass and calculate the density of the asteroid, which measures 134 kilometers in diameter. In addition ESA scientists say the information could one day save the planet.

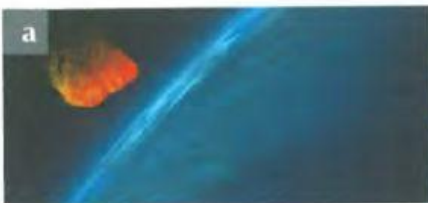
