

LA DIVISIÓN Y LA DIVISIÓN INVERSA

Figure 1 illustrates the division of three numbers by 3, 4, and 4, respectively. The results are shown in a grid format:

2845 : 3	2845 : 4	2543 : 4

The results are: 2845 : 3 = 948 R=1, 2845 : 4 = 711 R=1, and 2543 : 4 = 635 R=3.
