

LOOK!

He is the man **who** is carrying the lorry
(Él es el hombre quien está llevando el camión)

She is the woman **who** is wearing the long green skirt.
(Ella es la mujer quien está usando la falda larga verde.)

We use the relative pronoun **WHO** to make clear which person we are talking about
/ Utilizamos el pronombre relative **WHO** para aclarar de qué persona estamos hablando.

Examples:

- Homer is the man **who** is eating a donut.
(Homero es el hombre **quien** está comiendo una rosquilla)



- Lisa is the girl **who** is wearing an orange dress.
(Lisa es la niña **quien** está usando un vestido naranja.)

We use **WHO** only to talk about people. / Utilizamos **WHO** solo para hablar sobre personas.
