Adjectives

Words that describe nouns are called adjectives.
They usually answer the question "What kind?"



WRITING SKILLS



Adjectives are the same with a singular noun or a plural noun.

Example:

Venice is an old city.

(adjective)

(singular noun)

There are many old cities in Europe.

(adjective)

(plural noun)



Adjectives often come before nouns.

Example:

Only rich people can live in Venice.

(adjective) (noun)

Venice is a unique city.

(adjective) (noun)



Adjectives can also come after a form of the verb to be.

Example:

Venice is unique.

(form of verb to be) (adjective)

Houses are old.

(form of verb to be) (adjective)
