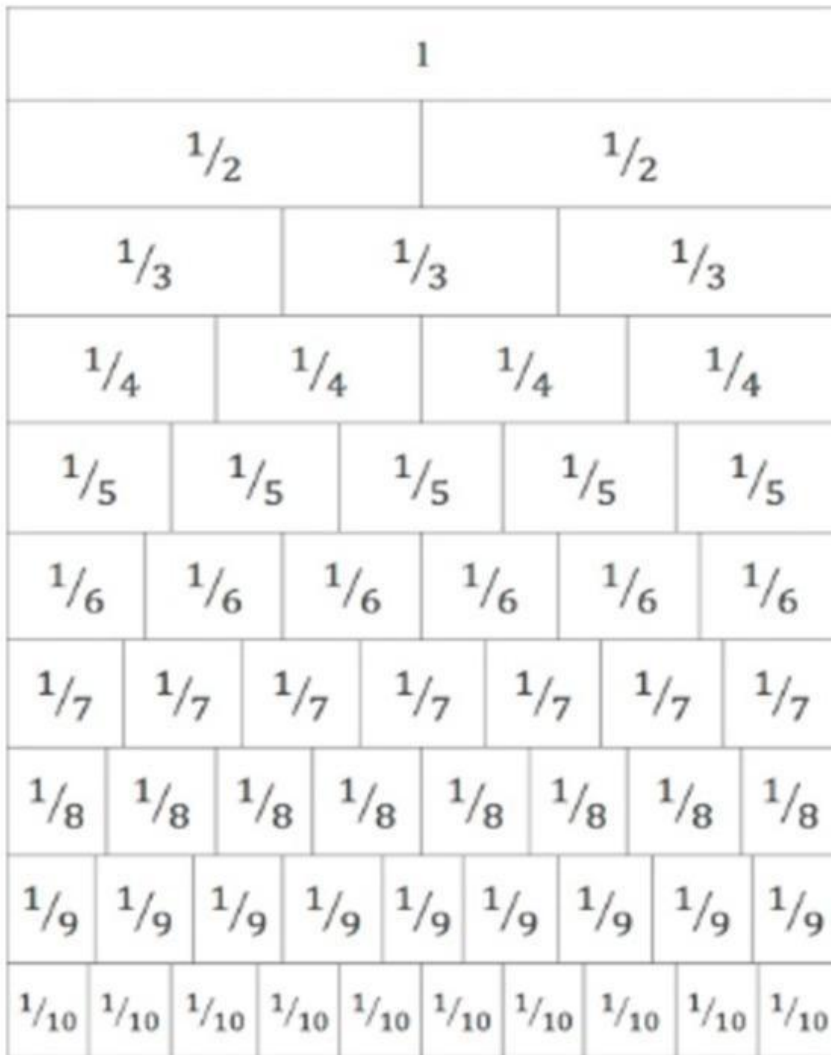


Equivalent Fractions
