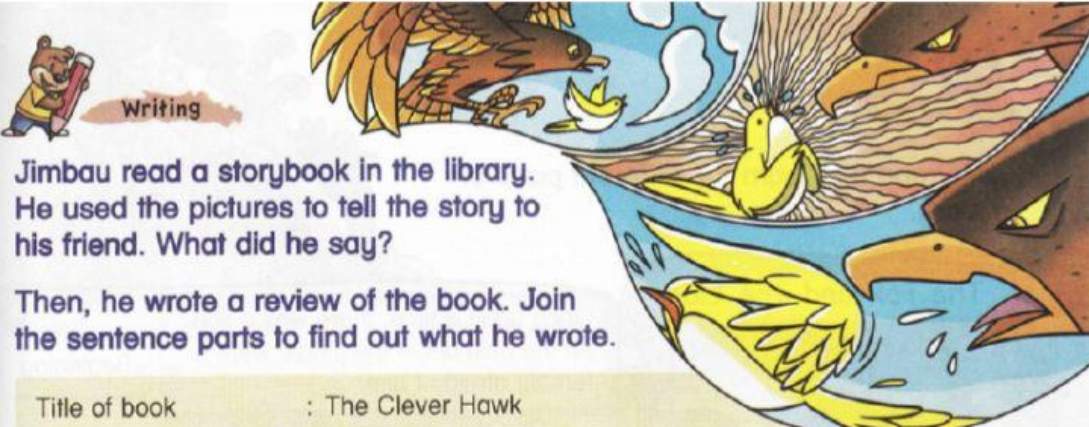

Then, he wrote a review of the book. Join the sentence parts to find out what he wrote.

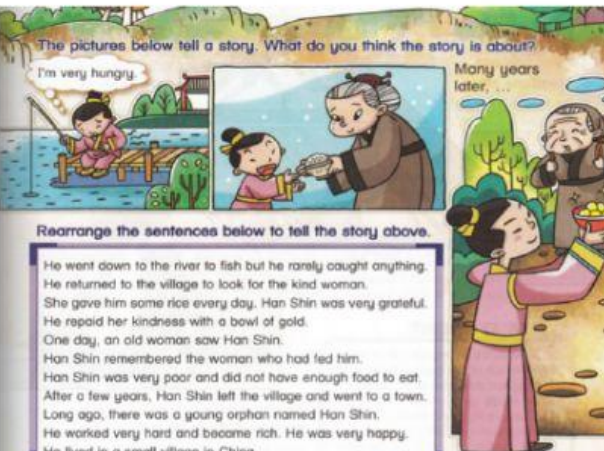
Title of book : The Clever Hawk
