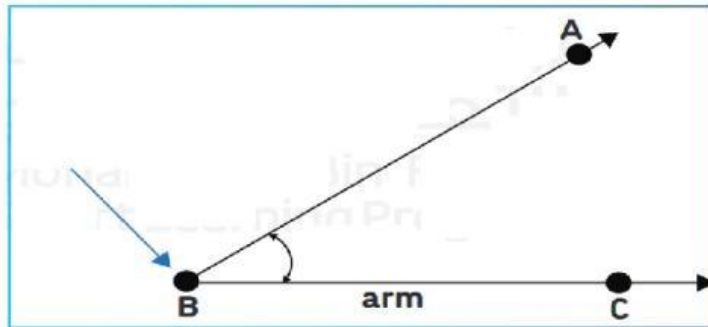


Angles and inclined lines

When **two straight lines meet at a point**, it is called an **angle**.

The **point of intersection between these lines** is called the **vertex**.

The lines creating the angle are called the **arms** of the angles as Angles are measured in degrees, and the symbol used to represent an angle is

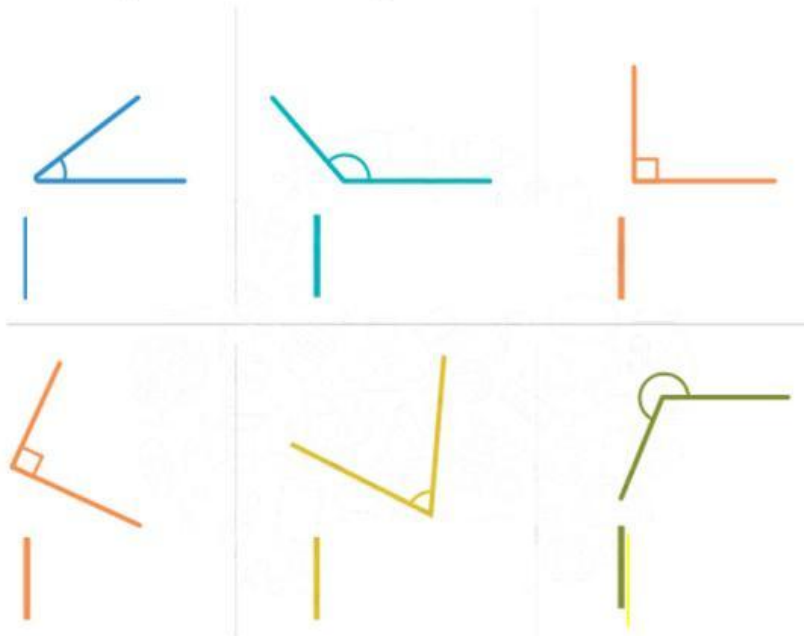


Vertex
