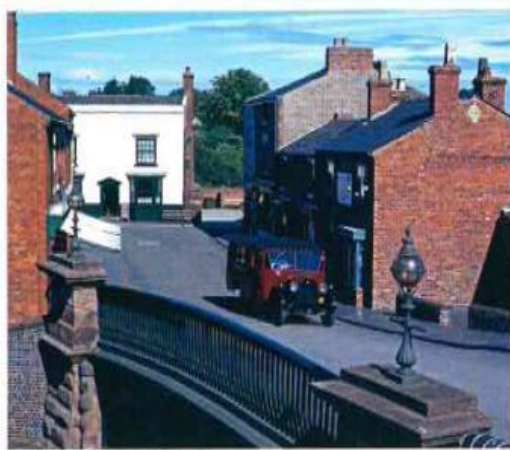

You can choose a home that is right for your family. There are four villages in the park: Lakeside is a quiet village by the lake and it's great for water sports. The Spa is near the sports and fitness centre and it's the place for active people. Choose from three types of home:

Flat: one bedroom – for just two people or parents with a baby.

Mini-home: two bedrooms – for a family of four or five people. This is ideal if you just want a place to sleep and eat.

Villa: three bedrooms with a sofa bed in the living room for up to eight people. This house is great for a big group or for a family that likes to spend time at home. There's a small garden at the front.

All the homes have a balcony with chairs. Inside there are modern kitchens with a cooker, fridge, table and chairs. The bedrooms have carpets on the floor, comfortable beds and lots of cupboards. The living-rooms have sofas, armchairs and televisions.

All the bathrooms have showers and the biggest houses have a bath and shower in the bathroom.

Pets are welcome in the holiday park.

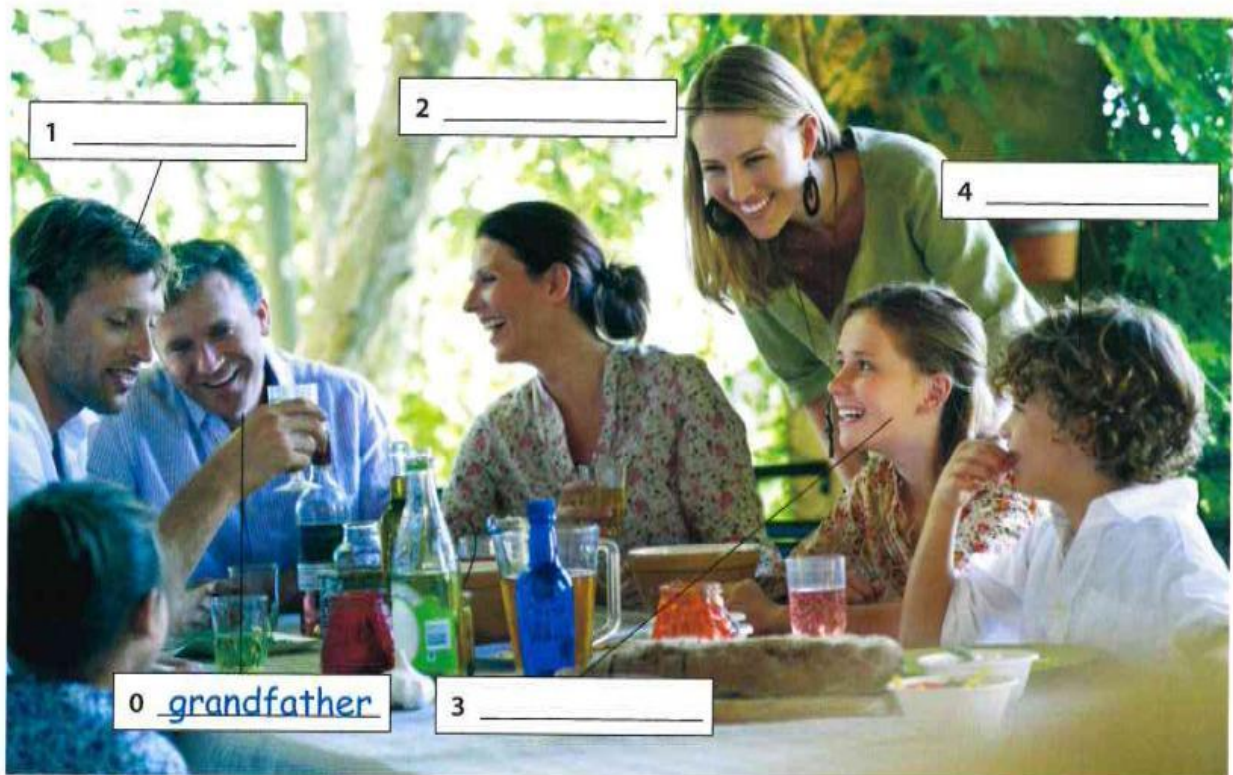
