With the rising costs of housing, renting and buying can be difficult and, for some, even impossible. With creativity and imagination, young people are finding solutions like these.

**A Moving back in with parents**

If you have struggled to buy a house or pay rent, moving back in with your parents may be an option. It doesn't have to be a permanent solution, but it can provide comfort and financial stability.

**B Apartment sharing**

Apartment sharing is a way of having some independence but without having the responsibility to pay all expenses yourself. Choose your roommates carefully, find an apartment that suits all of you, and be prepared to compromise.

**C Houseboats**

In many cities with access to water, houseboats are all the rage. The price of buying and renovating a houseboat is much less than buying or renting a house. **D Metal shipping containers**

Metal shipping containers can be transformed into houses. You need to make sure you purchase the right size. And you need to be aware of the building regulations in your area. It's best to find a contractor who has previous experience making houses out of shipping containers.
