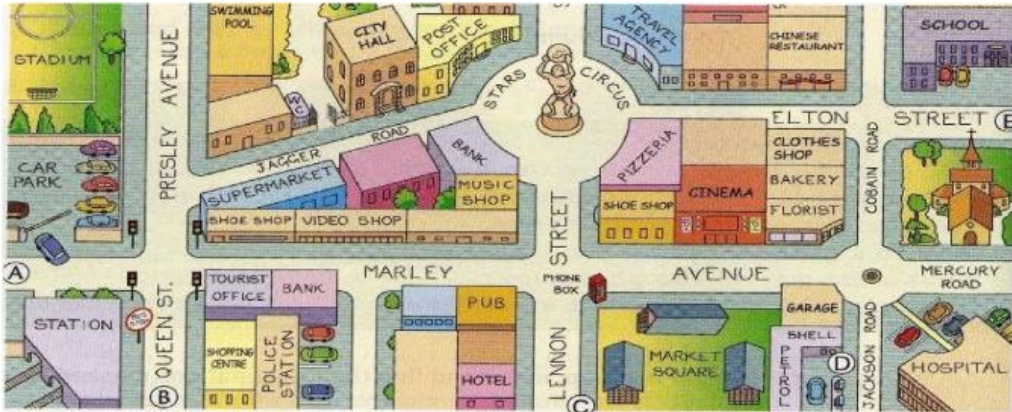


THERE IS THERE ARE
