No one in ... be / V + as + adj/adv + as + S

No one in my class is as tall as Jones.

No one in my class is as talkative as David.

= S + be / V +

the short adj + est + in
the most + long adj

Jones is the tallest in my class.

David is the most talkative in my class.

(Not) equal comparison = comparative
