The Brief

Despite the growing importance of technology in education, your school seems to lag in integrating technology effectively into early childhood classrooms. Teachers express reservations about the appropriateness of technology for young learners, leading to minimal use of digital resources. Your students need to identify the research gap and formulate a problem statement addressing this issue.

Current literature lacks comprehensive insights into the effective integration of technology in early childhood education, especially in terms of identifying age-appropriate digital resources and addressing teachers' concerns about the impact on traditional teaching methods.

The Process

1. Situation : Read and Identify the issues
2. Argue : Brainstorm the problems, causes and solutions
3. Decide: Decide what the key points of the problem statement are.
4. Solution: Write the potential solution(s) and include them in the problem statement
