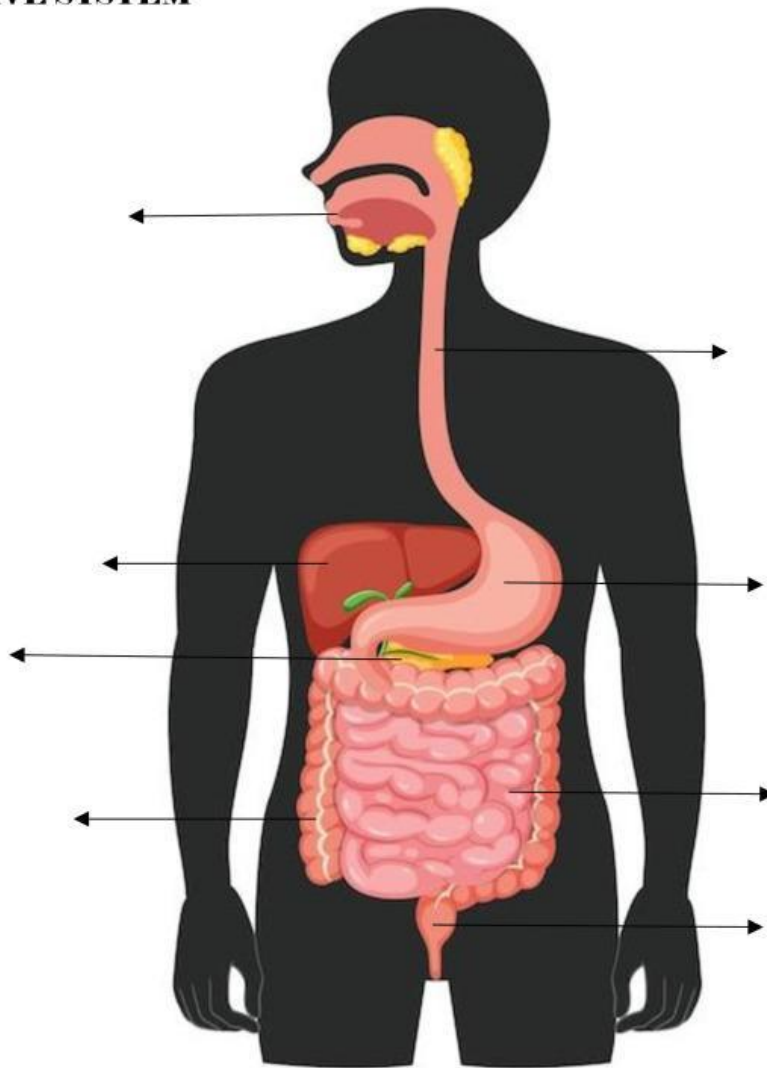


## THE DIGESTIVE SYSTEM



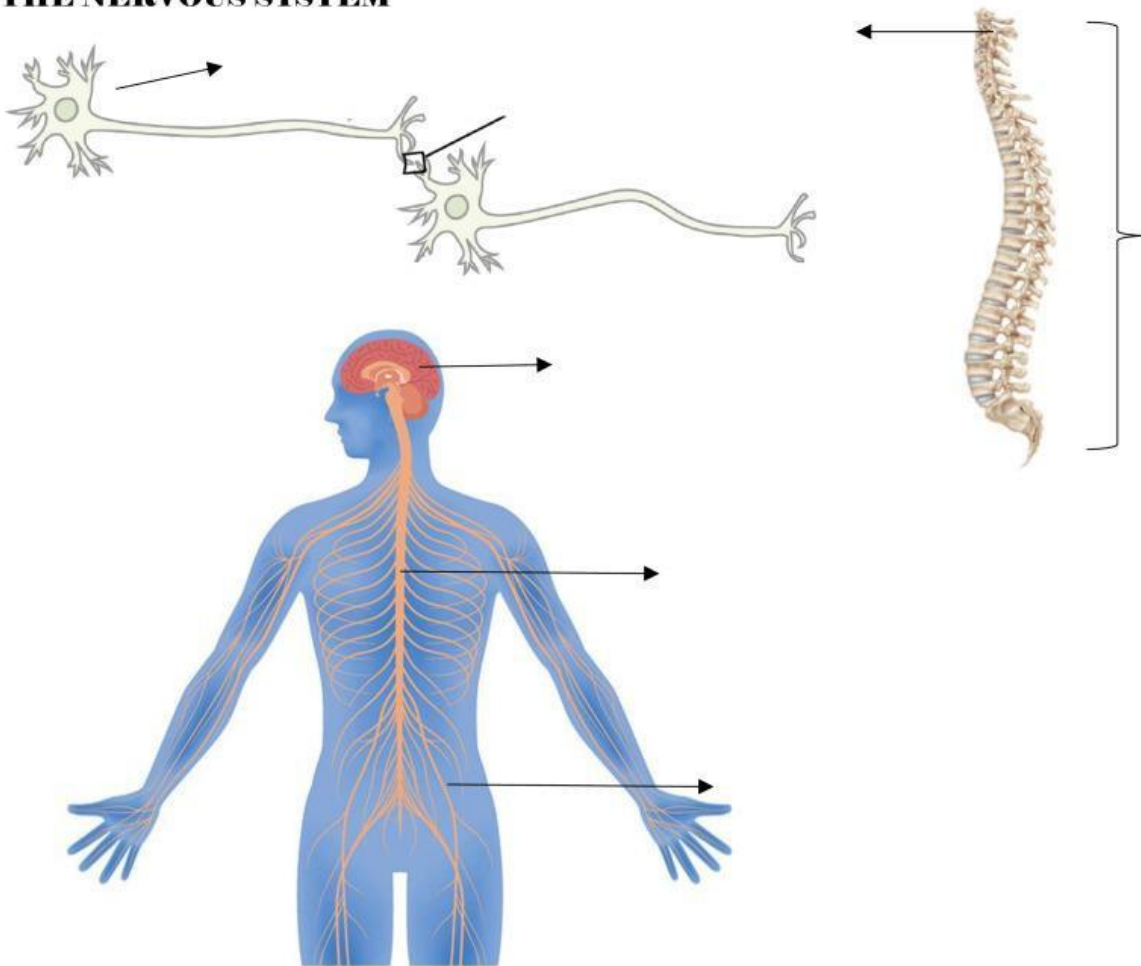
### DISEASES OR CONDITIONS

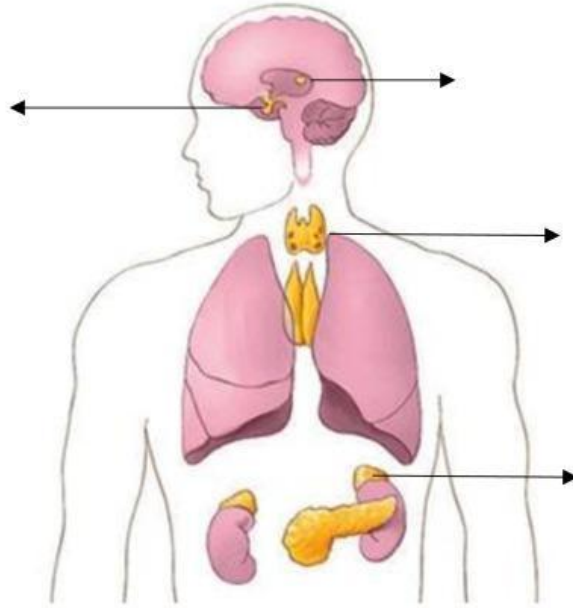
## DISEASES OR CONDITIONS

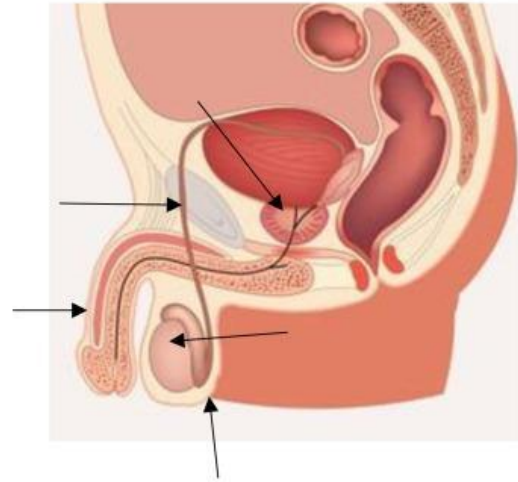
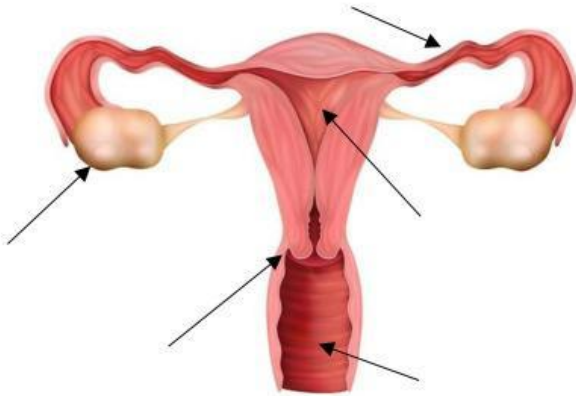

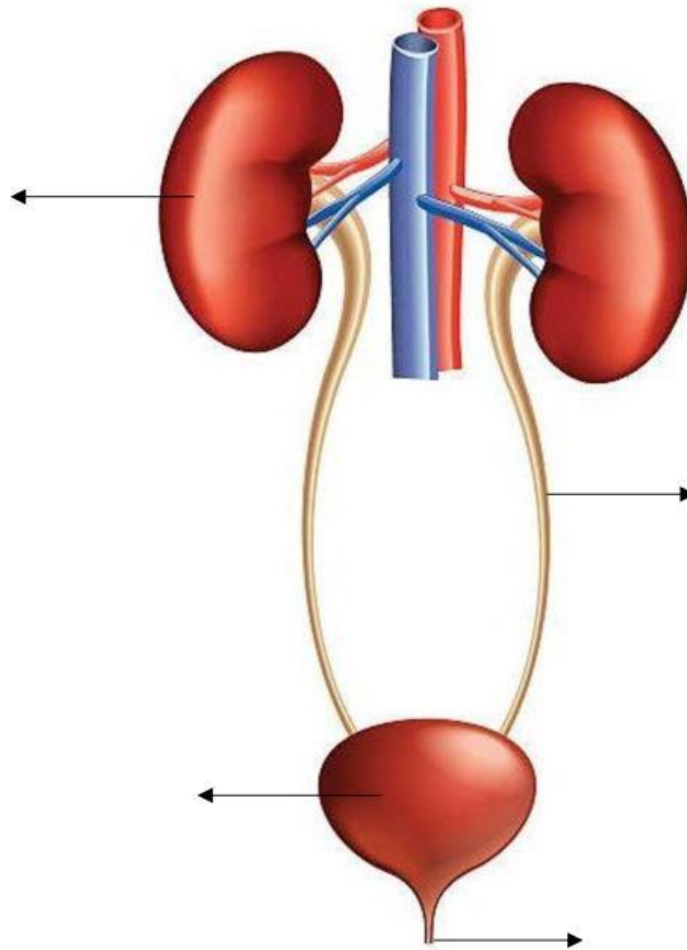
