sightseeing (n) /ˈsaɪtˌsiːɪŋ/	the activity of visiting places and buildings when you travel	Let's go sightseeing around Venice.
swimsuit (n) /ˈswɪmsuːt/	a piece of clothing you wear for swimming	She forgot to bring her swimsuit to the beach.
postcard (n) /pəʊstkaːrd/	a card with a picture on one side, used for sending messages	Bob bought some postcards for his friends.

Past Simple forms of "to be"

I, He, She, It → was/wasn't

You, We, They → were/weren't

Affirmative

He **went** to the beach yesterday.

Negative

He **didn't go** to the beach yesterday.

Question

- **Did** he **go** to the beach yesterday? – Yes, he **did**. / No, he **didn't**.
- Where **did** he **go** yesterday?
