In August 2019, a French inventor became the first person to (1) cross the English Channel on a 'flyboard' or 'hoverboard' – a board powered by a (2) jet pack. Franky Zapata crossed the Channel on a board he made himself. It took him just 20 (3) minutes to travel from Sangatte, in northern France, to Dover, in England. The board had five turbines and was powered by fuel in the inventor's backpack. He (4) carried enough fuel for 10 minutes, so halfway through the (5) journey, he needed to land on a boat to pick up more fuel for the second half. The first time Franky tried to cross the Channel, two weeks (6) earlier, he fell into the sea!
