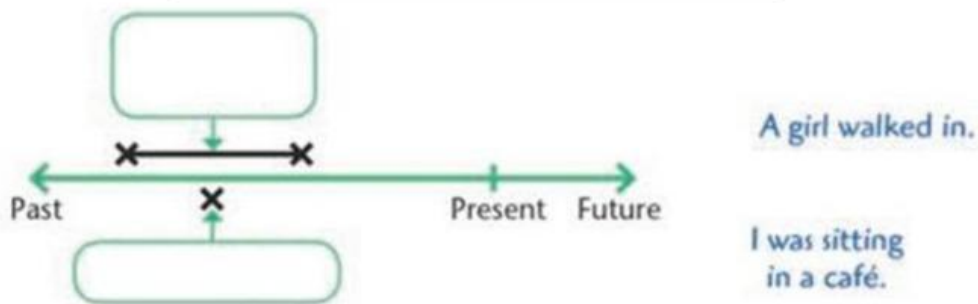

Past continuous + WHEN + past simple

I was watching the news when I heard the scream.

We were playing outside when it started to snow.

Past simple + WHILE + past continuous

I heard the scream while watching the news.

It started to snow while we were playing outside.
