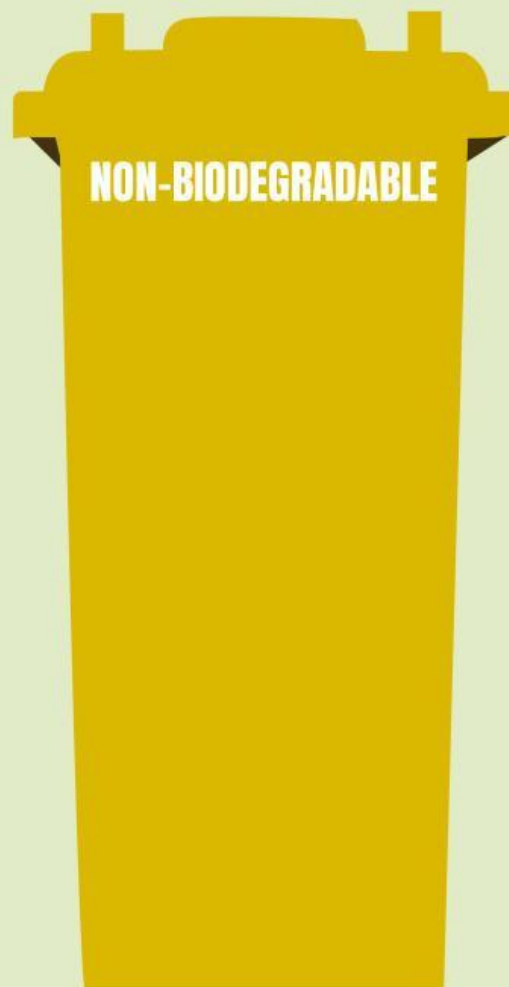

Newspaper editorials,
political speeches,
advertisements.

COMMUNICATIVE PURPOSE

To persuade the readers to agree with the writer.

TEXT ORGANIZATION

01

Thesis

Presents an introduction of the issue concerned in an opening statement.

02

Arguments

Present a series of arguments to convince and lead the readers to believe the writer's viewpoint (provides the evidence)

03

Recommendation

Strengthens the writer's viewpoint by stirring up the readers' feeling and directs them to follow or agree to the writer's recommendation.
