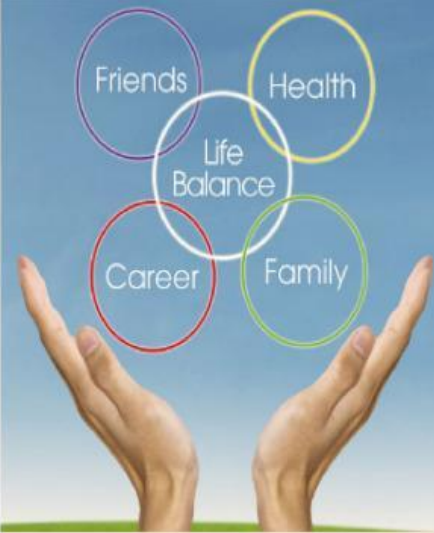

They showed that the more people use computers outside the office, the higher their stress levels, but at the same time, the more likely they are to have a higher level of personal satisfaction.
