I have /I've got	I haven't got	Have I got?*
You have / you've got	You haven't got	Have you got?
<b>He has / he's got</b>	<b>He hasn't got</b>	<b>Has he got?</b>
<b>She has /she's got</b>	<b>She hasn't got</b>	<b>Has she got?</b>
<b>It has / it's got</b>	<b>It hasn't got</b>	<b>Has it got?</b>
We have / we've got	We haven't got	Have we got?
You have / you've got	You haven't got	Have you got?
They have /they've got	They haven't got	Have they got?

<b>Affirmative</b>	<b>Negative</b>	<b>Question</b>
<b><i>You <u>have got</u> a car</i></b>	<b><i>You <u>haven't got</u> a car</i></b>	<b><i><u>Have you got</u> a car?</i></b>
They have got a book		
We have got a house		
Mary has got a pencil	(Mary=she)	
You have got a notebook		
Tom has got a beard	(Tom= he)	
Ann has got a dog	(Ann= she)	
We have got short hair		
Tigers have got sharp claws	(Tigers= they)	
This tiger has got stripes	(This tiger=it)	
Lions have got a mane	(Lions= they)	
Peter and Tom have got a black bag	(Peter and Tom = they))	
This flamingo has got long legs	(this flamingo=it)	
David has got long hair	(David=he)	
Susan and Tom have got glasses	(Susan and Tom=they)

Have I got <i>a cat</i> ?*	Yes, I have / No, I haven't *	
Have you got <i>a moustache</i> ?	Yes, I have / No, I haven't	
<b>Has he got <i>green eyes</i>?</b>	<b>Yes, he has / No, he hasn't</b>	
<b>Has she got <i>short hair</i>?</b>	<b>Yes, she has / No, she hasn't</b>	
<b>Has it got <i>beautiful feathers</i>?</b>	<b>Yes, it has / No, it hasn't</b>	
Have we got <i>glasses</i> ?	Yes, we have / No, we haven't	
Have you got <i>a pet</i> ?	Yes, we have / No, we haven't	
Have they got <i>two books</i> ?	Yes, they have / No, they haven't
