Grammar Box: Superlatives	
We use them to describe an extreme quality in a group.	
Form	Examples
One-syllable adjectives: add -est .	The peregrine falcon is the fastest flying bird in the world.
One-syllable adjectives ending in vowel + consonant: double the consonant and add -est .	The polar bear is the biggest land carnivore.
Most adjectives with two or more syllables: use the most before the adjective.	The inland taipan is the most venomous snake on Earth.
Two-syllable adjectives ending in -y: change the y to i and add -est .	Saltwater crocodiles are the heaviest reptiles on Earth.
Irregular adjectives: good – the best , bad – the worst	White sharks have the best sense of smell of all sharks.

Heads Up!

Saltwater crocs or "salties" are the **largest** of all crocodilians and can stay submerged for more than an hour.
