

Connectors "and" "but"

We use them to connect sentences / Los utilizamos para conectar oraciones.

Ejemplo: I like pears **and** bananas (Me gustan las peras **y** las bananas)

I like bananas **but** I don't like oranges. (Me gustan las bananas **pero** no me gustan las naranjas)

- **AND** means "y". We use it to add information / **AND** significa "y". Lo utilizamos para agregar información:

Alonso likes computer games **and** playing football
(A Alonso le gustan los juegos de computador **y** jugar fútbol)

- **BUT** means "pero". We use it to show opposite ideas/
BUT significa "pero". Lo utilizamos para mostrar ideas contrarias.

Joaquín likes reading **but** he doesn't like dancing.
(A Joaquín le gusta leer, **pero** no le gusta bailar)

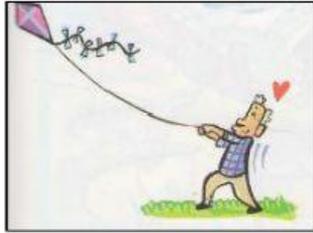
