Dogs in the Classroom

- (1) It isn't typical for most kids to see animals at school.
But now there is a new **program** that brings dogs into the classroom.
The dogs help the students learn important lessons and make new friends.

The program is great for new students at the beginning of the school year.

- (5) Many students feel **nervous** when they move to a new school,
but when they play with the dogs, or feed them it helps the kids relax.
New students can sit next to the dogs in class so they don't feel **lonely**.
They can also join the other students when they play with the dogs
after class. This way, all the students have something they can do together.
- (10) The program also shows students how to **pay attention** to **body language**.
When the students look at a dog's body language, they can
understand what the dog feels. For example, the students realize that when
a dog jumps, it feels excited, and when a dog **shakes**, it feels scared.
The students learn that when they look at people's body language,
(15) they can understand what they feel, too.

The program is **even** good for the dogs. They come from animal
shelters. They don't get a lot of food or love there. At the schools, students
take care of the dogs and give them everything they need.

Today, more than 4,000 schools in America and Canada use this program.
