

The Italian city of Venice is trying to ease the impact of mass tourism and the new rules will come into effect from June, the city said in a statement.

The use of loudspeakers has been banned as they can "generate confusion and disturbances" and comes after a €5 (£4.50) fee for day-trip visitors was trialled in September.

Over-tourism is widely recognised as an urgent issue for the canal city, prompting more and more residents to leave.
