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I. Materi Pokok : Asking and offering for help

II. Tujuan : Pada akhir pembelajaran siswa dapat mengungkapkan ungkapan meminta dan memberi pertolongan/jasa.

III. Materi Pendahuluan :

1. Vocabulary : Activity/ chores = mopping, washing the dishes, dusting, shoveling the snow, watering the plant, drying the dishes, vacuuming, sweeping the floor, washing the clothes etc
2. Percakapan-percakapan yang memuat ungkapan ungkapan berikut:

Meminta dan memberi Pertolongan

The expressions to ask for someone's help

Can you help me, Please help me, Can you do me a favour, please?,

Would you be so kind as to...?

The expression to give help to someone

Let me give you a hand, May I help you, May I help you with..., Sir/Ma am?

To accept and reject someone's help

Of course, Ok

No, It's not necessary

Thank you for offering, but...

Materi Asking and Offering for Help

Asking and Offering for Help merupakan salah satu bentuk ekspresi (*expression*) dalam Bahasa Inggris. Kalimat yang biasa digunakan pada kondisi atau ekspresi *Asking and Offering for Help* ini biasa diawali dengan penggunaan modal *Auxiliaries*.

Modal *Auxiliaries* yang digunakan bisa berupa *can, could, will, would, shall, should, may, might*, dan juga *must*.

Sebab materi *Asking and Offering for Help* banyak digunakan dalam percakapan Bahasa Inggris sehari-hari, terutama dalam keadaan membutuhkan pertolongan dari orang lain, atau sebaliknya menawarkan bantuan kepada orang lain.

Contoh Kalimat *Asking and Offering for Help*

No.	Kalimat Ekspresi (<i>Expression</i>)	Terjemahan
1.	Can you help me?	Bisakah kamu menolongku?
2.	Could you please give me a hand?	Bisakah kamu menolong saya?
3.	Would you like to help me?	Maukah kamu menolongku?
4.	Would you mind to come to my house?	Bisakah kamu datang ke rumahku?
5.	Could you pass the salt over there, please?	Bisakah kamu mengoper garamnya, tolong?
6.	Could you take the garbage outside?	Bisakah kamu membawa sampahnya keluar?
7.	Could you bring me the newspaper?	Bisakah kamu membawakanku koran?
8.	Could you please open the door?	Bisakah kamu membukakan pintunya?
9.	Could you lend me some money?	Bisakah kamu meminjamkan aku uang?
10.	Can you please come here for a second?	Bisakah kamu datang kesini sebentar saja?

Responses for Accepting for Help (Tanggapan menerima untuk membantu)

Sedangkan bentuk-bentuk kalimat yang biasa digunakan pada saat menyatakan penerimaan atau kesediaan untuk membantu (*responses for accepting for help*) diantaranya sebagai berikut:

1. Okay (*Baiklah*)
2. Yes, I can. (*Ya, aku bisa*)
3. Okay, No Problem. (*Tentu, tidak masalah*)

4. Sure (*Tentu saja*)
5. Certainly (*Tentu saja*)
6. No Problem (*Tidak masalah*)

Selain bentuk kalimat untuk menyatakan tanggapan menerima atau menyatakan kesediaan membantu (*responses for accepting for help*), terdapat juga bentuk kalimat untuk menyatakan penolakan atau tidak bersedia membantu (*responses for declining for help*).

Kalimat penolakan atau ketidaksediaan untuk membantu (*responses for declining for help*) dapat dilihat di bawah ini.

Responses for Declining for Help (*Tanggapan penolakan untuk membantu*)

1. I'm sorry, I can't. (*Maafkan aku, aku tidak bisa*)
2. Sorry, I Can't do it. (*Maaf, aku tidak bisa melakukannya*)
3. Sorry, I'm busy. (*Maaf, aku sibuk*)
4. You better manage it on your own. (*Kau urus saja sendiri*)
5. I'm afraid I can't do it. (*Aku takut aku tidak bisa melakukannya*)

Contoh Kalimat Offering for Help

Bentuk ekspresi *offering for help* merupakan bentuk ekspresi kalimat yang menunjukkan penawaran berupa bantuan kepada orang lain yang sekiranya membutuhkan pertolongan.

Kalimat-kalimat yang biasa digunakan pada saat *offering for help* diantaranya sebagai berikut.

1. May I help you? (*Bolehkah aku membantumu?*)
2. Would you like to help me? (*Bisakah kau membantuku?*)
3. Could you pass the salt over there, please? (*Bisakah Anda mengoper garam di sebelah sana tolong?*)
4. Would you like to come to my house? (*Bisakah kamu datang ke rumahku?*)
5. Would you mind if I sit here? (*Apa tidak apa-apa jika aku duduk disini?*)
6. Open the window, please. (*Buka jendelanya, tolong.*)
7. Could you please move to another chair? (*Bisakah kamu pindah ke kursi lain tolong?*)
8. Would you like a cup of coffee? (*Maukah kamu secangkir kopi?*)
9. Could you please tell me where is the library? (*bisakah kamu menunjukkan dimana perpustakaan?*)
10. Would you like to take the garbage outside please? (*maukah kamu membawa sampah keluar tolong?*)
11. May I give you a hand? (*Bisakah aku membantumu?*)
12. Shall I bring you a pillow? (*haruskah aku membawakanmu bantal?*)
13. Can I do the dishes for you? (*bisakah aku mencuci piring untukmu?*)
14. Shall I help you with your project? (*haruskah aku menolongmu dengan tugasmu?*)
15. Would you care for another cup of tea? (*maukah kamu secangkir teh lagi?*)

Accepting Offers (Menerima Bantuan)

Kalimat-kalimat atau pernyataan yang biasa digunakan pada saat menyatakan penerimaan atas tawaran bantuan yang diberikan oleh orang lain disebut dengan *Accepting Offers*.

Contoh kalimat *Accepting Offers* (menerima bantuan) diantaranya sebagai berikut.

No.	Kalimat Ekspresi (<i>Expression</i>)	Terjemahan
1.	Thank you	Terima kasih
2	Yes, please.	Ya, tolong.
3.	I'd like it very much.	Aku akan sangat menyukainya.
4.	I'm pleased to do that.	Aku senang melakukannya.
5.	With pleasure, thank you.	Dengan senang hati, terima kasih.
6.	Yes, please. I really appreciate it.	Ya, tolong. Aku sangat menghargainya.
7.	Thank you, it's very kind of you.	Terima kasih, kamu baik sekali.
8.	Yes, please, that would be lovely.	Ya tolong, itu akan sangat menyenangkan.

Declining Offers (Menolak Bantuan)

Sedangkan kalimat-kalimat atau pernyataan yang biasa digunakan untuk menyatakan penolakan atas tawaran pemberian bantuan dari orang lain dikenal dengan sebutan *Declining Offers*.

Contoh bentuk kalimat *Declining Offers* yang biasa digunakan sebagai berikut.

No.	Kalimat Ekspresi (<i>Expression</i>)	Terjemahan
1.	No thanks.	Terima kasih
2.	I can't, thanks anyway.	Aku tidak bisa, terima kasih
3.	No, I really won't, thank you.	Tidak, aku tidak mau, terima kasih.
4.	It's okay, I can do it by myself.	Terima kasih, aku bisa melakukannya sendiri.
5.	No thank you.	Tidak terima kasih.
6.	No thanks, I don't need any help.	Tidak terima kasih, aku tidak membutuhkan bantuan.
7.	Don't worry, I will do it by myself.	Jangan khawatir, aku akan melakukannya sendiri.
8.	That's alright, I will manage it on my own.	Tidak apa-apa, aku akan melakukannya sendiri.

Contoh Dialog Offering for Help

Dalam kehidupan sehari-hari, seringkali terjadi percakapan atau dialog dalam Bahasa Inggris yang berisi permintaan bantuan atau pertolongan dari seseorang kepada orang lain atau koleganya.

Berikut contoh dialog *Offering for Help*

Dialogue 1

Danny	:	Hello, Waiter. Can you come here for a second?
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Waiter	:	Sure. What can I help you, sir?
Danny	:	Could you bring me some salt?
Waiter	:	Yes, sir. And would you like to try some coffee? We have the best quality in this town.
Danny	:	Wow! It would be really lovely to try it.
Waiter	:	Ok, sir. Is there anything can I help you with?
Danny	:	No, thanks. I think it's enough.
Waiter	:	Okay. I will bring it to you now.

Dialogue 2

Hani	:	Hey, you looks pale. What's wrong with you?
Ben	:	My stomach hurts. Maybe this is because I didn't take breakfast this morning.
Hani	:	May I bring you to the UKS?
Ben	:	Sure, it would be really helpful.
Hani	:	Would you like to me to bring you some foods?
Ben	:	Yes, please.
Hani	:	Okay. But, I will take you to the UKS first, then I will bring you foods and medicine.

Ben	:	Thanks, Hani. It's very nice of you.
Hani	:	It was friends are for.

Contoh Dialog Asking for Help

Dialogue 1

Ryan	:	Hello, Ms. Rina. You looks so busy, may I help you?
Ms. Rina	:	Yes, I am. Could you please bring student's homework books in my table?
Ryan	:	Sure, and where should I bring it to?
Ms. Rina	:	Please bring the books to your class, and say sorry to your friends that I may coming late to the class.
Ryan	:	Okay, Ms. Rina. Is there anything else?
Ms. Rina	:	No, it's enough. Thank you very much for your help Ryan.
Ryan	:	Your welcome.
