sensibly (adv)	doing sth in a rational/clever way
beg (v)	to ask other people for sth they have because you need it very much <u>e.g</u> There are many poor people begging for money in the streets.
gatekeeper (n)	a person who controls who enters a place
defend (v)	to make danger or attack go away, to protect

bargain (n)	a deal, agreement between two people that is good for both of them
bargain (v)	to agree to do sth, if somebody does sth for you
admiral (n)	the commander of a navy (all ships in a country)
