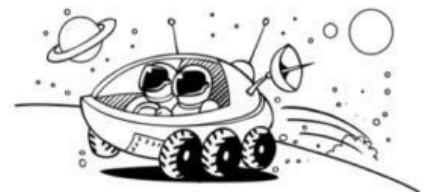

Communication through the ages

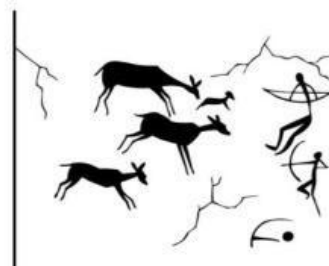
People were able to communicate with each other long before text messages and tweets existed. At first, sign language was used. Gradually, people began to speak and eventually the first writing systems appeared.

The first writing systems were painted on the walls of caves like those found in Altamira in northern Spain. These prehistoric paintings showed pictures of animals such as bison.

In ancient Egypt, pictograms, also called hieroglyphics, were used to depict objects and ideas. After the discovery of the Rosetta Stone, we were able to understand their meaning. The Rosetta Stone had translations of the Egyptian hieroglyphics into ancient Greek so people could translate the symbols and understand their meaning.

Later, the Chinese system of writing was developed using characters rather than letters. In this form of writing there isn't an alphabet, a character may represent a whole word.

Nowadays, we use symbols and characters to send text messages. Modern technology has introduced many different forms of written communication, such as chat messages, blog posts and email. So, the next time you send a message to someone and add a smiley face emoticon, consider it a modern pictogram!
