

DIFFERENT WAYS TO PARAPHRASE

- 1. Synonym Replacement (Dùng từ đồng nghĩa để thay thế)**
"The environment is **at risk** due to pollution."
=> "Pollution is **endangering** the environment."
- 2. Change Word Forms (dùng từ loại khác để thay thế) (N-V):**
Original: "As men and women have to work full time, household duties should be equally **divided**."
=> Paraphrase: "There should be an even division of household chores between males and females."
Original: **Eating too much** fast food poses a threat to overall well-being.
⇒ Paraphrase: **Excessive consumption** of fast food poses a threat to overall well-being.
- 3. Use of Pronouns: (This – That – These – Those – Which)**
Original: "The company **experienced** a **significant increase** in profits. **This** increase was due to **improved** sales."
Paraphrase: "The company **saw** a **substantial rise** in profits, **which** resulted from **enhanced** sales."
- 4. Reorder the Sentence:**
Original: "To succeed in business, you must work hard."
Paraphrase: "Working hard is essential for success in business."
- 5. Change Sentence Structure:**
Original: Big cities often provide more job opportunities, which leads to an increasing number of people moving from the countryside to urban areas. (MĐQH đầy đủ)
=> Big cities often provide more job opportunities, leading to an increasing increasing number of people moving from the countryside to urban areas. (Participle clause – MĐQH rút gọn)
- 6. Replace Active Voice with Passive Voice or Vice Versa:**
Original: "Scientists **have discovered** a new planet."
Paraphrase: "A new planet **has been discovered** by scientists."
- 7. Use of Cause and Effect Language:**
Original: "The rise in oil prices **led to** an increase in transportation costs."
Paraphrase: "The increase in transportation costs was a **consequence of** the surge in oil prices."
- 8. Add Synonyms or Additional Information (thêm thắt thông tin): (Dùng thận trọng!)**
Original: "The book is about climate change."
Paraphrase: "The book focuses on the topic of climate change, **discussing its causes and impacts**."
- 9. Use of Modifiers (thêm trạng từ, phó từ...): (Dùng thận trọng!)**
Original: "The cat is very cute."
Paraphrase: "The cat is **incredibly adorable**."
- 10. Substitute Specific Terms with General Ones (Hyponym-Hypernym) (chung chung – cụ thể hoặc ngược lại): (Dùng thận trọng!)**
Original: "I enjoy playing video games."
Paraphrase: "I like engaging in **digital entertainment**."

Hoa – Hoa hồng (phạm vi to – nhỏ) or Sports – football (phạm vi to – nhỏ)

PRACTICE CORNER

1. Strict punishments for driving offences are the key to ensuring road safety.

- Strict punishments = more stringent penalty = heavy (driving) penalties = a heavy course of punishments = violation penalties/ fines = impose sanctions for driving offences = Stern penalties = rigorous ...
- Driving offences = Dangerous drivers = traffic violations = traffic law breakers = break traffic laws
- Ensure road safety = make our roads safer = promote safe driving = reduce road/traffic accidents
- *Optimal/ comprehensive/ultimate + solution to + NOUN*
- *Adopt/ implement/ enact/ impose + solutions*

- Countries = nations
- The average weight of people = people's average weight
- Overweight = obese
- Fitness = their time spent on physical activities
- Decreasing = on the decrease --- Increasing = on the increase

3. **The increasing use of computers and mobile phones in communication has negative effects on young people's reading and writing skills.**

- The increasing use = the high use = the growing use = the heavy dependence = heavy reliance
- Has negative/detrimental effects = have adverse impacts = negatively affect (v)
- Young people = the young = the youth = teenagers = students (for example)

4. **Nowadays, many families have both parents working. Some working parents believe other family members like grandparents can take care of their children, while others think childcare centres provide the best care.**

- Family members = close relatives
- Childcare centres = childcare organisations = childcare corporations = childcare settings = organisations that offer/ provide babysitting service
- Take care of their children = look after their children = care for their children = children are taken care of...
