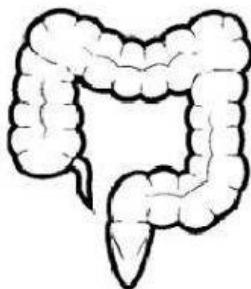
SMALL INTESTINE
