1 Think about the writing style. Find other examples in the newspaper articles on page 50.

1 Write a title:
Shark in Sydney!

2 Start with an opening statement: Children were swimming in the ocean when they saw the animal.

3 Write the facts. Who? Children
When? Yesterday afternoon
Where? City Beach

4 Say what happened (use past tense or past progressive tense): While the children were playing, a man was diving in the ocean.

5 End the story with the words a person says:
He said, "It wasn't a dangerous shark. It was a dolphin!"



Work it out.

Look at the example: She said, "It was amazing."

Do we use quotation marks (" ") before and after a question? or before and after the words a person says?
