Sugar Glider

The Sugar Glider is a marsupial mammal. It is belonging to marsupial infra class. The Sugar glider does not fly it glides. They glide from branch to branch. The sugar glider launches itself from a tree then spreading it's limb to exposes the gliding membranes.
