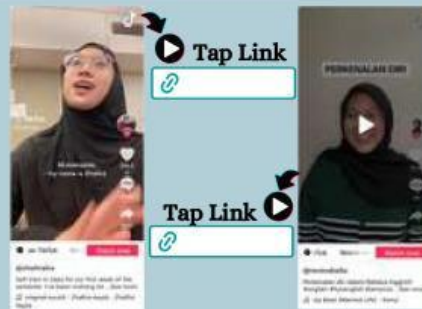

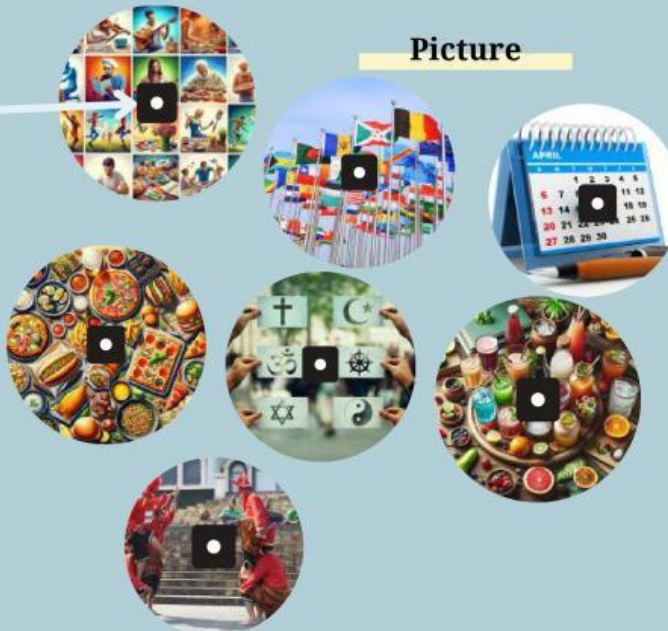

Grammar Focus

Study the following pronouns.

Pronouns

Pronouns (kata ganti): is a word that is used as a substitute for a noun or noun phrase in self-introductions and other activities. In this case, nouns can be people, things, places, actions, or ideas. These nouns can be non-living nouns or living nouns. The main function of pronouns is to prevent repetition of words in a sentence. **Pronouns** are divided into several types according to their function: Subjective, Objective, Possessive Adjective, and Possessive Pronoun.

1) Subjective Pronoun (SP)

To replace people/things in the subject position, you can use pronouns. Example: **She** is a student, I am Sean, etc.

3) Possessive Adjective (PA)

Possessive Adjectives are not used to replace nouns but rather to explain the ownership of an object. Possessive Adjectives are used before nouns.

possessive adjective + a noun

Example: **My** Hobby, **Your** Hobby, etc.

2) Objective Pronoun (OP)

To replace people/things in the object position, you can use pronouns. Example: Sean tells **me**, I know **her**, etc.

4) Possessive Pronoun (PP)

Possessive Pronouns are used to show ownership of something obvious. In its use, Possessive Pronouns cannot be followed by a noun.

Example: This book is **yours**, that pen is **mine**, etc.
