Borobudur is one of historical buildings in Indonesia. It is located in Magelang, Central Java. Not only it became a well known tourism destination to a lot of travelers around the world, Borobudur Temple is also included in UNESCO list of world heritage site.

Borobudur temple consists of six square floors and three circular floors which arranged accordingly and make it to be stair-like layers that you have to climb one by one to reach the top of the temple. In the middle of the floor, you will find small stairwell with couples of stairs connecting each floor that you can use as a passage to go to the top. On each level of the floor, there are a lot of relief panels and Buddha statues spread around it. Based on the data, there are 2.672 panels and 504 statues in total. There is a dome located on the top center of the temple and is surrounded by 72 Buddha statues, each seated inside a perforated stupa.

Task 4

Study the explanation below.

The text in task 3 is a description text. Descriptive text is text that has the aim of explaining or describing something, someone, an object, an animal, a place or other things. The descriptive text has two parts: identification and description.

No	Parts of the Text	Function of the Parts
1.	Identification	Identification contains an introduction or explanation of the character, which can be a person, object, place or event to be described. This section is located in the first paragraph. <u>Example: The name, the location, etc.</u>
2.	Description	The description section contains a clear and specific explanation of the characteristics, traits, habits or other things related to the object to be described. <u>Example: The construction, the design, the size, the color, etc.</u>

The descriptive text has 4 special characteristics.

1. Use simple present tense
2. Using lots of nouns and adjectives

Using specific principle nouns, such as my cat, my swain, and monument. Apart from that, adjectives are also used to clarify the use of nouns, such as a giant house, a large stupa, etc.

3. There is an action verb

Using the verb principle shows an activity or an activity principle that can be seen. For example, climb, sleep, walk, and so on.

4. Descriptive text only has one focus; it is only to explain one object.



GRAMMAR FOCUS

Special characteristics of descriptive text.

Simple present tense

The simple present tense is used to express events that occur regularly, routinely, or are usually carried out in the present.

A sentence in any tense can be verbal or nominal.

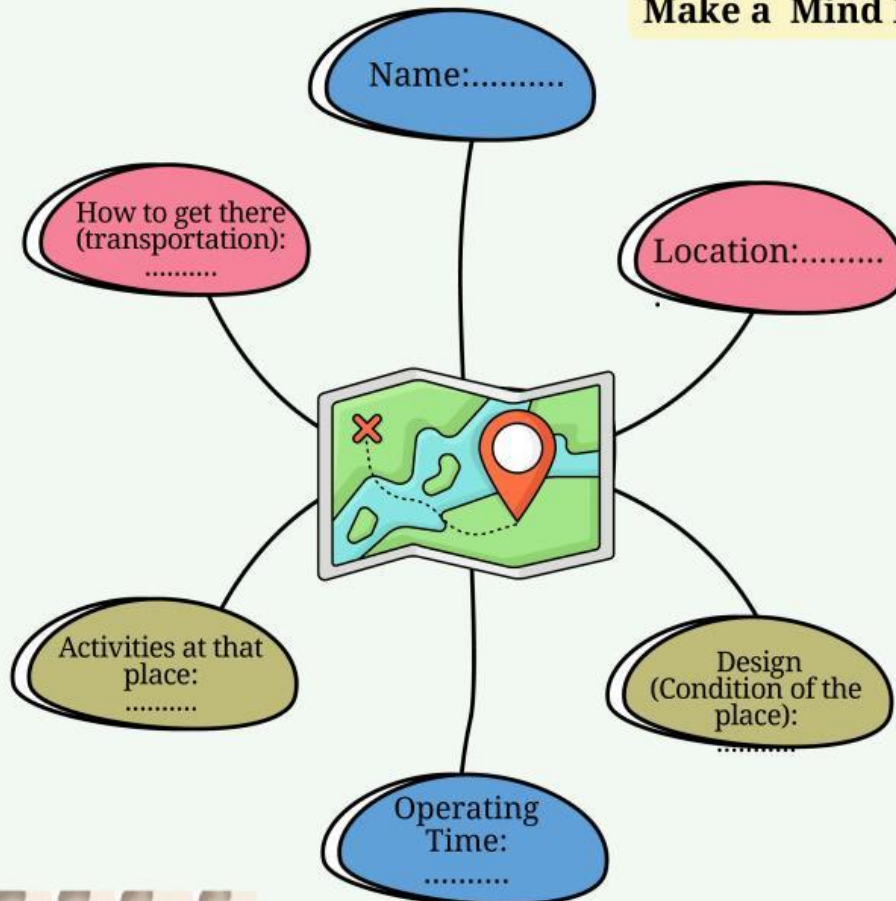




Task 9

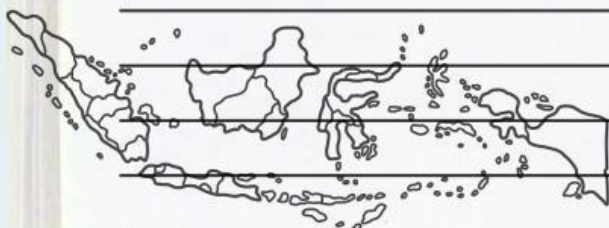
