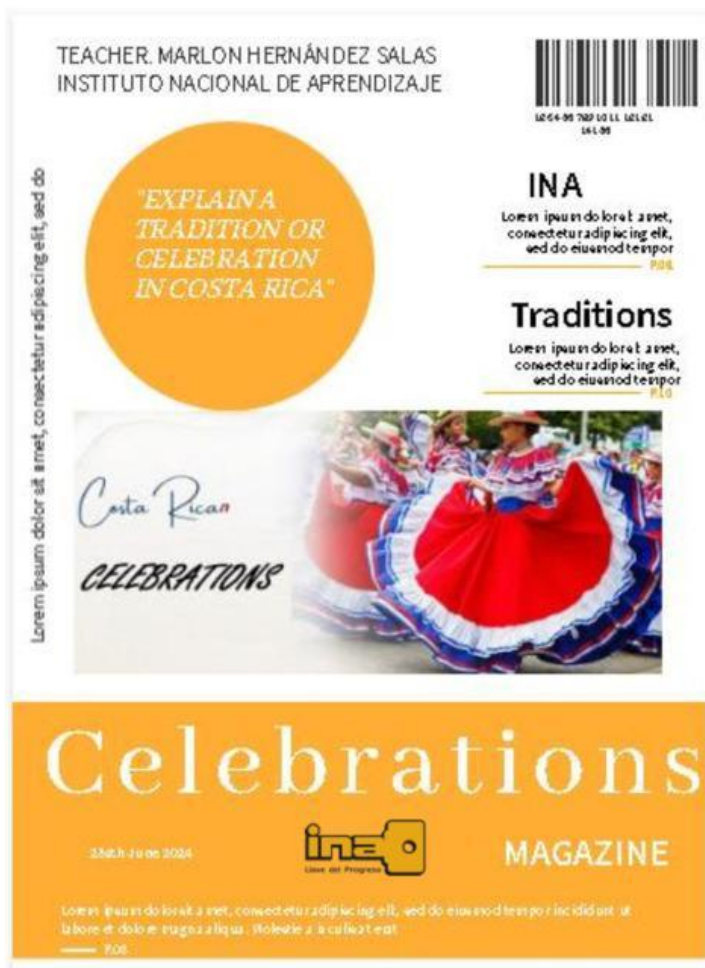




Holidays
