1 Eggs à la Provençale

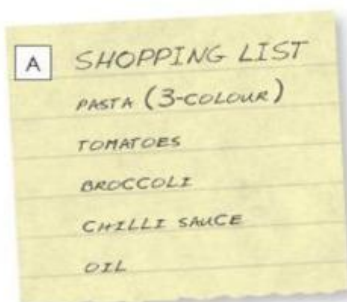
A dish with a sophisticated name, but in fact it's very simple. Mix together three eggs, some tomato sauce, a small onion, and some salt and pepper. Put some oil in a frying pan and when it's hot, add the egg mixture. Stir it around and 'There you go!'

2 Pasta salad

This is a flexible dish, so you can eat it every day. Mix together some cooked pasta – I like three-colour pasta – and two types of cooked vegetables (e.g. broccoli, tomatoes, corn on the cob, green peppers). Add some oil and chilli sauce, stir it around ... and enjoy!

3 Cola chicken

Cola chicken is simple to make. You need a chicken, some cola, an onion and a green pepper. Cut up the chicken, the onion, and the green pepper and put them together in a pan. Add some cola, some herbs and spices, and cover it with aluminium foil. Bake it at 350 degrees for one hour.
