in: in the background, in the morning/afternoon/evening, interested in

at: at the age of, look at, at the same time, be good at

on: depend on, on time, on+day/date, on purpose

for: prepare for smth (but prepare **to do** smth)

No prepositions: influence sb/sth, affect sb/sth, call sb, text sb, go home, go abroad, go downtown, answer the phone, answer the questions
