Richard

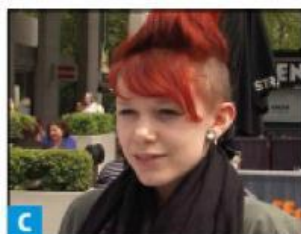
