



	<p>Relative clauses famous women</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- pick a card – famous <u>women</u>- guess who <u>is that</u> – search on internet- prepare short 1 minute presentation about her using as many relative clauses as <u>possible</u> <p>then in pairs exchange information and count how many relative clauses were used.</p>
5	<p>Longest sentence</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- students are given a sentence – they <u>have to</u> make it as long as possible by adding non-defining relative clause (count the words, ask students with highest scores to read it)
	<p>Non defining rel. clauses about us</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- students get strips of <u>paper</u>- each student writes their name and fold <u>it</u> so the name doesn't show – they give it to me, we mix the sheets together and they pick one
5	<p>Extra activity: Relative clauses</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- give students cards with things/people/places/... from our everyday <u>lives</u>- they have to describe the items to a woman from 19th century using relative <u>clauses</u>- in pairs they take turns, guess
