A two-hour flight takes you from **the / -** Minsk to **the / -** Vaclav Havel Airport. The airport was renamed in 2012 after the last president of **the / -** Czechoslovakia and the first president of **the / -** Czech Republic.

**The / -** Czech Republic is now part of **the / -** European Union and the country wants to have a short geographic name - **the / -** Czechia. The country is going to use its full name too, like “**the / -** France” and “**the / -** French Republic”.
