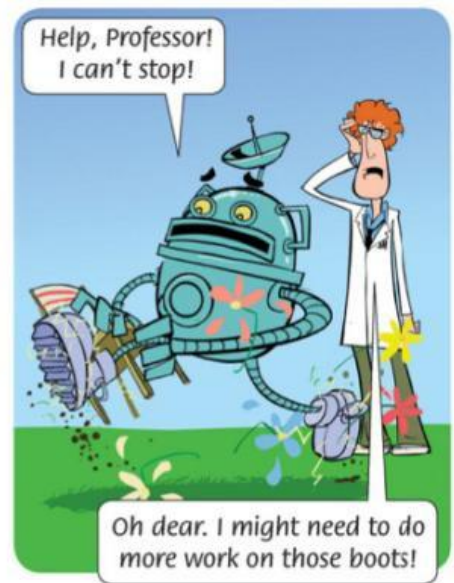
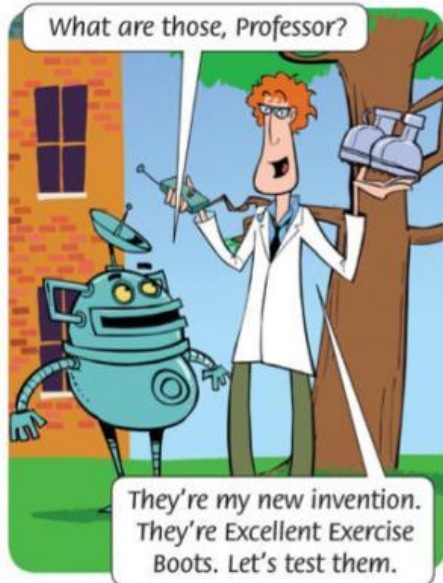

Use **will** and **won't** to talk about future definites.

They **'ll** be a big success.
