Hindu Holi Festival

Holi gets its name from Holika, a demones in Hindu mythology. The festival is a reminder of the victory of good over evil. The Hindus believe that faithful and dedicated people will be protected.

In the festival, Indian families prepare gujiya, a dumpling-like sweet filled with dried fruits and nuts. Some common ingredients are cashews, coconut, and raisins.

Some people also drink bhang, a milky liquid. People started drinking this milkshake about 3,000 years ago. They connect this drink to Shiva – the powerful god in Indian mythology.

In this celebration, people also dye their faces with many colours. Each colour has a special meaning. For example, red means love, fertility, and marriage; green is a symbol of a new start. In the past, people made colours with natural materials like flowers and spices. Now, synthetic dyes are commonly used. Most of them are from China, even though the government encourages using local products and natural plant-based dyes.
