We usually form the past simple of regular verbs by adding –ed to the end of the verb.

walk

walked

Some verbs end with an e, so we just add -d.

breathe

breathed.

Some verbs end with a short vowel followed by one consonant. For these verbs, we double the consonant and add -ed.

stop

stopped
