Samantha: Hello Tony. It's me Samantha.

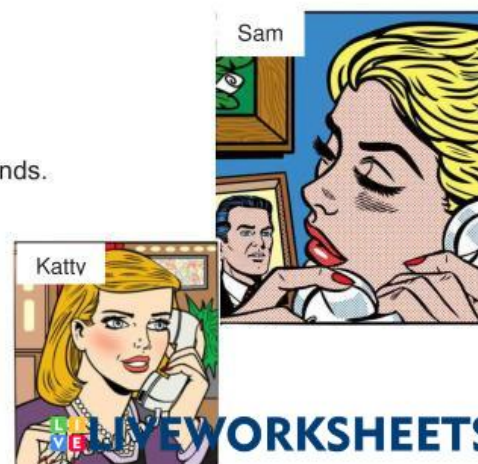
Tony: Hi Sam. How are you?

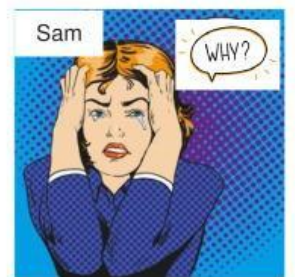
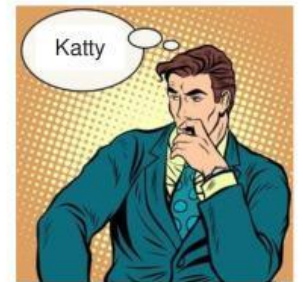
Samantha: I'm good. I'm cooking dinner now.
