**Alcatraz** <sup>1</sup>is located (locate – Present Simple) in San Francisco Bay. It was a prison from 1933 to 1963 and during that time there were just fourteen escape attempts. The attempted escape in 1962 <sup>2</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (probably remember – *will*) as the most famous one. Frank Morris and the Anglin brothers dug a tunnel out of their cells and then disappeared. The three men may have drowned but their bodies <sup>3</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (never discover – Present Perfect).
