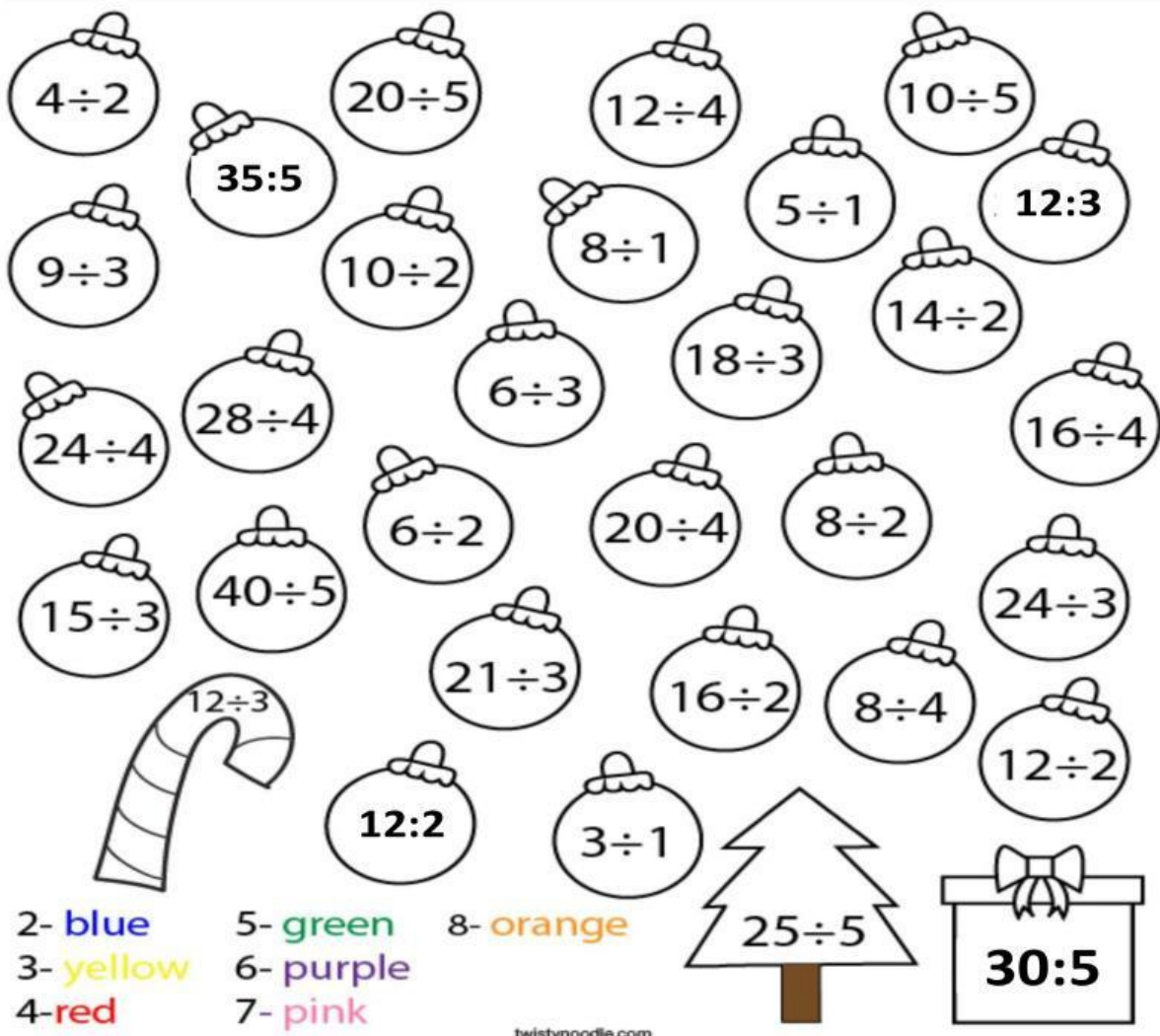


Question 1: Divide and color.**Question 2: Divide and write numbers**
